Top 5 Furniture Fails in K-12 (and how to avoid them)

Wobbly tables within a year.

Why it happens: Low-gauge frames, weak fasteners.

Fix: Industrial-strength construction + proper load testing.

Surfaces ruined by markers, chemicals, or cleaners.

Why: Cheap laminate or thin coatings.

Fix: Lab-grade or high-pressure surfaces with chemical/stain resistance.

Furniture that can't adapt.

Why: Fixed casework, no modularity.

Fix: Use RGX-style modular systems that can be reconfigured as programs evolve.

Looks bad after one semester.

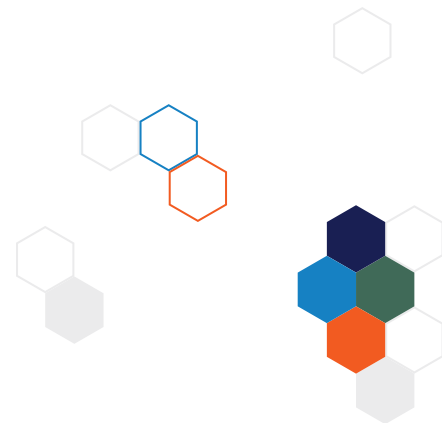
Why: Durability wasn't considered in finishes/materials.

Fix: Choose finishes designed for high-traffic, high-touch environments.

Replacement costs every few years.

Why: Buying "cheap now" vs. "smart long-term."

Fix: Invest in durable platforms with replaceable parts — not disposable furniture.
